SECTION 1. Article 2 of Chapter 115D of the General Statutes is amended by

(a) Purpose. – There is established the NC Works Career Coach Program to place						
community college career coaches in high schools to assist students with determining career

(b) Memorandum of Understanding. – The board of trustees of a community college						
and a local board of education of a local school administrative unit within the service area of the community college shall enter into a memorandum of understanding for the placement of						
career coaches employed by the board of trustees of the community college in schools within						
the local school administrative unit. At a minimum, the memorandum of understanding shall						
include the following:

<u></u>	<u>a.</u>	Hiring, training, and supervision of career coaches. The board of				
	_	trustees may include a local board of education liaison on the hiring				
		committee and in the decision-making regarding hiring for the coach				
		positions.				
	<u>b.</u>	Salary, benefits, and all other expenses related to the employment of				
		the coach. The coach will be an employee of the board of trustees				
		and will not be an agent or employee of the local board of education.				
	<u>c.</u>	Development of pedagogical materials and technologies needed to				
		enhance the advising process.				
	<u>d.</u>	Criminal background checks required by the local school				
		administrative unit for employees working directly with students.				
	<u>e.</u>	Agreement that, while on any school campus, the coach will obey all				
		local board of education rules and will be subject to the authority of				
		the school building administration.
