2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE DISTRICT ATTORNEYS TO USE CERTAIN GRANT FUNDS
3 TO OBTAIN TOXICOLOGY ANALYSIS FROM PROVIDERS OF TOXICOLOGY
4 ANALYSES OTHER THAN HOSPITALS.
5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6 SECTION 1. Section 18B.4 of S.L. 2013-360 reads as rewritten:
7 "SECTION 18B.4. Of the funds appropriated in this act to the Judicial Department, the
8 sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) in the 2013-2014 fiscal year shall be allocated
9 to the Conference of District Attorneys and shall be used to establish a grant fund to provide
10 district attorneys across the State with the resources to obtain toxicology analysis from local
11 ~~hospitals~~ hospitals, or from other providers of toxicology analyses, on persons charged with
12 driving while impaired whose conduct did not result in serious injury or death to others. The
13 Conference of District Attorneys shall report to the Chairs of the Joint Legislative Oversight
14 Committee on Justice and Public Safety by October 1, 2014, on the expenditure of these
15 funds."
16 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
