Short Title: Study/Transfer Global TransPark to Commerce. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators D. Davis and Pate (Primary Sponsors).

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY AND ADVISABILITY OF TRANSFERRING
3 THE NORTH CAROLINA GLOBAL TRANSPARK AUTHORITY FROM THE
4 DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** Study. – The Department of Transportation, in consultation with the
7 Department of Commerce, shall study the feasibility and advisability of transferring the North
8 Carolina Global TransPark Authority from the Department of Transportation to the Department
9 of Commerce. The study shall consider all of the following:

- 10 (1) The Strategic Plan developed by the North Carolina Global TransPark
11 Authority, including (i) whether the goals set forth in the Strategic Plan are
12 being met, (ii) what performance measures are being used to measure
13 success or progress in meeting the goals set forth in the Strategic Plan, and
14 (iii) whether any adjustments or updates to the Strategic Plan are necessary.
15 (2) Any benefits that may arise from the transfer, including any cost-savings or
16 efficiencies that may be achieved.
17 (3) Any issues that may arise from the transfer, including legal, financial, or
18 other requirements that must be met to effectuate the transfer.
19 (4) The type of transfer under G.S. 143A-6 that should be utilized to effectuate
20 the transfer.
21 (5) Any other matters or information the Department of Transportation deems
22 relevant to the study.

23 **SECTION 2.** Report. – The Department of Transportation shall report its findings
24 and recommendations, including any legislative proposals, to the Joint Legislative
25 Transportation Oversight Committee no later than February 1, 2016.

26 **SECTION 3.** Effective Date. – This act is effective when it becomes law.
