Short Title: NCNG Members/Reemployment Asst. Priority. (Public) Sponsors: Representative G. Martin. Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO GRANT MEMBERS OF THE NORTH CAROLINA NATIONAL GUARD REEMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE PRIORITY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 165-44.2 reads as rewritten: "§ 165-44.2. Veteran defined. For the purposes of this Article, "veteran" means a person who served on active duty (other than for training) in any component of the Armed Forces of the United States for a period of 180 days or more, unless released earlier because of service-connected disability, and who was discharged or released from the Armed Forces of the United States under honorable conditions. The term also includes a member of the North Carolina National Guard who was discharged or released from the National Guard under a general discharge or honorable conditions."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
