Sponsors: Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO DIRECT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE TO STUDY ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL FOR HIGH-ACHIEVING, SEVERELY **ECONOMICALLY** DISADVANTAGED STUDENTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study establishing a residential public high school for high-achieving, severely economically disadvantaged students. The Committee shall focus its study on the feasibility of establishing such a public school for students in grades 11 and 12 and any other issues it deems relevant. **SECTION 2.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall report the results of its study and any recommendations, including proposed legislation, to the 2015

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

General Assembly prior to reconvening in 2016.
