2 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION OVERSIGHT  
3 COMMITTEE TO STUDY ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL PUBLIC HIGH  
4 SCHOOL FOR HIGH-ACHIEVING, SEVERELY ECONOMICALLY  
5 DISADVANTAGED STUDENTS.  
6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  
7 **SECTION 1.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall study  
8 establishing a residential public high school for high-achieving, severely economically  
9 disadvantaged students. The Committee shall focus its study on the feasibility of establishing  
10 such a public school for students in grades 11 and 12 and any other issues it deems relevant.  
11 **SECTION 2.** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall report the  
12 results of its study and any recommendations, including proposed legislation, to the 2015  
13 General Assembly prior to reconvening in 2016.  
14 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
