SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund or from any available		
federal Block Grant funds to the Department of Health and Human Services the sum of eight		
hundred thou	sand dollars (\$800,000) for the 2015-2016 fiscal year for child advocacy	centers.
The funds shall be allocated as follows:		
(1)	Seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to be allocated	equally
	among each of the 30 fully certified child advocacy centers in this Sta	ıte.
(2)) Fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to be allocated to Children's Ac	lvocacy
	Centers of North Carolina, Inc., to hire a quality improvement	ent and
	development coordinator.	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
