"§ 20-136.2. Air bag installation. Counterfeit and nonfunctional air bags.

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to knowingly installimport, manufacture, sell, offer for sale, install, or reinstall any object in lieu of an air bag, other than an air bag that was designed in accordance with federal safety regulations for the make, model, and year of vehicle, as part of a vehicle inflation restraint system.a counterfeit air bag or nonfunctional air bag. Any person, firm, or corporation violating this section shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. H felony. In addition, a violation of this section shall constitute an unfair and deceptive trade practice under G.S. 75-1.1."

SECTION 4. This act becomes effective October 1, 2015, and applies to offenses
