1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROHIBITIONS ON CARRYING CONCEALED  
3 HANDGUNS DO NOT APPLY TO NORTH CAROLINA ADMINISTRATIVE LAW  
4 JUDGES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-269(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

7 "(8) Any person who is an administrative law judge described in Article 60 of  
8 Chapter 7A of the General Statutes and who has a concealed handgun permit  
9 issued in accordance with Article 54B of this Chapter or considered valid  
10 under G.S. 14-415.24, provided that the person shall not carry a concealed  
11 weapon at any time while consuming alcohol or an unlawful controlled  
12 substance or while alcohol or an unlawful controlled substance remains in  
13 the person's body."

14 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 14-415.27 reads as rewritten:

15 **"§ 14-415.27. Expanded permit scope for certain persons.**

16 Notwithstanding G.S. 14-415.11(c), any of the following persons who has a concealed  
17 handgun permit issued pursuant to this Article or that is considered valid under G.S. 14-415.24  
18 is not subject to the area prohibitions set out in G.S. 14-415.11(c) and may carry a concealed  
19 handgun in the areas listed in G.S. 14-415.11(c) unless otherwise prohibited by federal law:

20 ...

21 (8) A North Carolina administrative law judge."

22 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2015.
