2	AN ACT TO ALLOW PARTIALLY DISABLED VETERANS TO PARK IN A
3	HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE WHEN DISPLAYING THE PARTIALLY
4	DISABLED VETERAN SPECIAL PLATE AND TO PROVIDE THAT MEDICAL
5	CERTIFICATION AND RECERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR HANDICAPPED
6	PARKING PRIVILEGES MAY BE SATISFIED BY A DISABILITY DETERMINATION
7	ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AFFAIRS
8	INDICATING THE PERSON IS HANDICAPPED.
9	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
10	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-37.6(e)(1) reads as rewritten:
11	"(1) To park or leave standing any vehicle in a space designated with a sign
12	pursuant to subsection (d) of this section for handicapped persons when the
13	vehicle does not display the distinguishing license plate, removable
14	windshield placard, or-temporary removable windshield placard as provided
15	in this section, or a disabled veteran registration plate issued under
16	G.S. 20-79.4; G.S. 20-79.4, or a partially disabled veteran registration plate
17	issued under G.S. 20-79.4;"
18	SECTION 2. G.S. 20-37.6(c1) reads as rewritten:
19	"(c1) Application and Renewal; Physician's Certification. – The initial application for a
20	distinguishing license plate, removable windshield placard, or temporary removable windshield
21	placard shall be accompanied by a certification of a licensed physician, a licensed
22	ophthalmologist, or optometrist or of <u>a licensed optometrist, or</u> the Division of Services for the
23	BlindBlind that the applicant is handicapped or by a disability determination by the United
24	States Department of Veterans Affairs that the applicant is handicapped. The application for a
25	temporary removable windshield placard shall contain additional certification to include the
26	period of time the certifying authority determines the applicant will have the disability.
27	Distinguishing license plates shall be renewed annually, but subsequent applications shall not
28	require a medical certification that the applicant is handicapped. Removable windshield
29	placards shall be renewed every five years, and the renewal shall require a medical
30	recertification that the person is handicapped. Temporary removable windshield placards shall
31	expire no later than six months after issuance."
32	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
