2 "SECTION 5.(a1) Effective October 1, 2017, G.S. 103-2(a) is amended by adding 4 a new subdivision to read:

"(5) Hunting on Sunday in a county having a population between 280,000 people and 700,000 people is prohibited."";

and on page 4, lines 27 and 28, by inserting between those lines:

moves to amend the bill on page 3, line 50, by inserting after that line:

"SECTION 5.(b1) Effective October 1, 2017, G.S. 153A-129 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(b1) Notwithstanding G.S. 103-2(a)(5), a county having a population between 280,000 people and 700,000 people may by ordinance allow hunting on Sunday as allowed under G.S. 103-2, provided the ordinance complies with all the following:

- (1) The ordinance shall be applicable from January 1 until December 31 of any year of effectiveness.
- (2) The ordinance shall allow for individuals hunting in an adjacent county with no restriction on Sunday hunting to retrieve any animal lawfully shot from the adjacent county.
- (3) The ordinance shall be applicable to the entire county."".
