1 moves to amend the bill on page 20, lines 22 through 32, by rewriting those lines to read:

3 "(k) It is unlawful to refuse to exhibit upon request by any inspector, protector, or other
4 law enforcement officer any item required to be carried by any law or rule as to which
5 inspectors or protectors have enforcement jurisdiction. The items that must be exhibited include
6 boating safety or other equipment or any license, permit, tax receipt, certificate, or
7 identification. It is unlawful to refuse to allow inspectors, protectors, or other law enforcement
8 officers to inspect ~~weapons, equipment, fish, or wildlife~~ that weapons or equipment if the
9 officer reasonably believes them to be possessed incident to an activity regulated by any law or
10 rule as to which inspectors and protectors have enforcement jurisdiction. ~~jurisdiction and the~~
11 officer has a reasonable suspicion that a violation has been committed, except that an officer
12 may inspect a shotgun to confirm whether it is plugged or unplugged without a reasonable
13 suspicion that a violation has been committed. It is unlawful to refuse to allow inspectors,
14 protectors, or other law enforcement officers to inspect fish or wildlife for the purpose of
15 ensuring compliance with bag limits and size limits. Except as authorized by G.S. 113-137,
16 nothing in this section gives an inspector, protector, or other law enforcement officer the
17 authority to inspect, in the absence of a person in apparent control of the item to be inspected,
18 any of the following:

- 19 (1) Weapons.
- 20 (2) Equipment, except for equipment left unattended in the normal operation of
21 the equipment, including, but not limited to, traps, trot lines, crab pots, and
22 fox pens.
- 23 (3) Fish.
- 24 (4) Wildlife.";
