Short Title: School Calendar Flex./Certain School Systems. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FLEXIBILITY FOR CERTAIN LOCAL BOARDS OF
3 EDUCATION IN ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates
7 of opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section.
8 Notwithstanding the opening date for students, all first semester examinations shall be given
9 before winter break.~~Except for year round schools, the opening date for students shall be no~~
10 ~~earlier than the Monday closest to August 26, and the closing date for students shall be no later~~
11 ~~than the Friday closest to June 11. On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education~~
12 ~~may waive the requirement that the opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday~~
13 ~~closest to August 26 and may allow the local board of education to set an opening date no~~
14 ~~earlier than the Monday closest to August 19, to the extent that school calendars are able to~~
15 ~~provide sufficient days to accommodate anticipated makeup days due to school closings. A~~
16 ~~local board may revise the scheduled closing date if necessary in order to comply with the~~
17 ~~minimum requirements for instructional days or instructional time. For purposes of this~~
18 ~~subsection, the term "good cause" means that schools in any local school administrative unit in~~
19 ~~a county have been closed eight days per year during any four of the last 10 years because of~~
20 ~~severe weather conditions, energy shortages, power failures, or other emergency situations.~~

21 ~~The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school~~
22 ~~that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to~~
23 ~~any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of~~
24 ~~modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."~~

25 **SECTION 2.** This act applies only to the Davidson County, Lexington City,
26 Montgomery County, and Thomasville City school administrative units.

27 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
28 the 2015-2016 school year.
