## Representative Harrison

moves to amend the bill on page 166, line 44, by inserting after that line a new provision to read:

## "SEDIMENTATION FEES

**SECTION 14.19.(a)** G.S. 113A-54.2(a) reads as rewritten:

"(a) An application <u>and compliance</u> fee of <u>sixty five dollars</u> (\$65.00)<u>ninety dollars</u> (\$90.00) per acre of disturbed land shown on an erosion and sedimentation control plan or of land actually disturbed during the life of the project shall be charged for the review of an erosion and sedimentation control plan under this Article."

**SECTION 14.19.(b)** G.S. 113A-54.2(a), as amended by subsection (a) of this section, reads as rewritten:

"(a) An-The Department shall charge an application and compliance fee to cover the costs of review of an erosion and sedimentation control plan under this Article.of ninety dollars (\$90.00) The fee shall be no less than ninety dollars (\$90.00) and no greater than one hundred seventy dollars (\$170.00) per acre of disturbed land shown on an erosion and sedimentation control plan or of land actually disturbed during the life of the project shall be charged for the review of an erosion and sedimentation control plan under this Article.project."

**SECTION 14.19.(c)** The funds generated from the fees levied pursuant to G.S. 113A-54.2(a), as enacted by this section, in the amount of five hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$530,000) in each year of the 2015-2017 fiscal biennium, shall be credited to the Sedimentation Account established by G.S. 113A-54.2(b) within the Department of Environment and Natural Resources. The proceeds of any fee charged by the Department under G.S.113A-54.2(a) in excess of ninety dollars (\$90.00) during the 2016-2017 fiscal year are subject to appropriation in a future year and shall not be used by the Department for any recurring expenses."

**SECTION 14.19.(d)** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated by this act for recurring increases in funding for State water and wastewater infrastructure grants shall be reduced by five hundred thirty thousand dollars (\$530,000) in each year of the 2015-2017 fiscal biennium.

**SECTION 14.19.(e)** Subsection (b) of this section becomes effective July 1, 2016.".
