moves to amend the bill on page 57, lines 39-40, by inserting between those lines a new section to read:

"NORTHEAST REGIONAL SCHOOL OF BIOTECHNOLOGY AND AGRISCIENCE/CIHS FUNDS

SECTION 8.31.(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Instruction under this act for the 2015-2017 fiscal biennium for the Cooperative and Innovative High Schools (CIHS) allotment to fulfill the funding requests for the eight new CIHSs approved by the State Board of Education shall be increased by the sum of three hundred ten thousand six hundred sixty-nine dollars (\$310,669) in recurring funds for each fiscal year of the biennium to also fulfill the funding request of the newly approved CIHS, Northeast Regional School of Biotechnology and Agriscience.

SECTION 8.31.(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the funds appropriated to the Community College System Office for the 2015-2017 fiscal biennium to fund the first phase of upgrading the System's information technology platform and the partial migration of servers to hosted storage services shall be decreased by the sum of three hundred ten thousand six hundred sixty-nine dollars (\$310,669) in recurring funds for each fiscal year of the biennium."; and

on page 1, line 32, by decreasing the amounts for the 2015-2016 fiscal year and the 2016-2017 fiscal year by \$310,669; and

on page 2, line 1, by increasing the amounts for the 2015-2016 fiscal year and the 2016-2017 fiscal year by \$310,669; and

by adjusting the appropriate totals accordingly.
