1 moves to amend the bill on page 57, lines 39-40, by inserting between those lines the following
2 new section to read:

4 **"STUDY ON JUVENILE LITERACY PROGRAM**

5 **SECTION 8.31.(a)** The Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee shall
6 study the results of the Juvenile Literacy Center program established in Wake County. In
7 conducting the study, the Committee shall do at least the following:

8 (1) Examine the impact of the program on (i) improving basic literacy skills, (ii)
9 reintegrating juveniles into schools, (iii) preventing criminal behavior and
10 recidivism, (iii) developing overall academic skills, and (iv) addressing
11 problem behaviors in school.

12 (2) Evaluate the existing program for potential expansion into other counties,
13 including projected costs, feasibility of implementation, and
14 recommendations for locations for additional programs.

15 **SECTION 8.31.(b)** The Committee shall report the results of its study and any
16 recommendations on the expansion of the program, including proposed legislation, to the 2015
17 General Assembly upon the convening of the 2016 Regular Session."
