- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 99, by inserting between lines 24 and 25, the following new  
 2 section to read:  
 3 **"REDUCE RESIDENTIAL HOSPICE FUNDS TO FUND CHILD FIRST AND NC**  
 4 **INFANT & YOUNG CHILD MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION**  
 5 **SECTION 12A.11.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the  
 6 nonrecurring funds appropriated in this act to the Department of Health and Human Services  
 7 for Residential Hospice (1910) for the 2015-2016 fiscal year shall be reduced by the sum of one  
 8 million ninety thousand dollars (\$1,090,000) in nonrecurring funds, and of those funds, the sum  
 9 of eight hundred thousand dollars (\$800,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2015-2016 fiscal  
 10 year shall be allocated to the Division of Social Services to provide funds for Child First for  
 11 first-year start-up funding for pilot models and the sum of two hundred ninety thousand dollars  
 12 (\$290,000) in nonrecurring funds for the 2015-2016 fiscal year shall be allocated to the  
 13 Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services to  
 14 provide funds to the North Carolina Infant & Young Child Mental Health Association  
 15 (NCIMHA) to be used as follows:  
 16 (1) Forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) for the development and implementation of  
 17 a communications strategy to increase awareness of the importance of young  
 18 children's mental, social, and emotional health.  
 19 (2) One hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the development  
 20 of a web-based clearinghouse of programs and services for young children  
 21 with mental health needs.  
 22 (3) One hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to develop the  
 23 workforce that provides social, emotional, and mental health services and  
 24 supports for early childhood."
