1 moves to amend the bill on page 8, lines 32-33

2 by inserting the following between those lines:

"SECTION 10.(e) G.S. 14-403 reads as rewritten:

"§ 14-403. Permit issued by sheriff; form of permit; expiration of permit.

5 The sheriffs of any and all counties of this State shall issue to any person, firm, or 6 corporation in any county a permit to purchase or receive any weapon mentioned in this Article 7 from any person, firm, or corporation offering to sell or dispose of the weapon. The permit 8 shall expire five years from the date of issuance. The permit shall be in the following form: be a 9 standard form created by the State Bureau of Investigation, shall be of a uniform size and 10 material, shall contain a watermark, and shall be designed to minimize the ability to counterfeit 11 or replicate the permit and shall be set forth as follows:

Therefore, a permit is issued to \_\_\_\_\_\_ to purchase one pistol from any person, firm or corporation authorized to dispose of the same.

25 The standard permit created by this section shall be used statewide by the sheriffs of any 26 and all counties and when issued by a sheriff shall also contain an embossed seal unique to the 27 office of the issuing sheriff."

SECTION 10.(f) Permits issued pursuant to Article 52A of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes prior to the effective date of subsection (e) of this section shall remain valid until expiration. Any person possessing a valid permit issued prior to the effective date of subsection (e) of this section may exchange that permit for an updated permit from the sheriff
