Designates \$2,427,975 for Boys and Girls Clubs across the State in each year of the 2015-2017 fiscal biennium and allows nonprofits providing mentoring services to compete for the additional funds thereafter. Total availability for purpose is increased to \$14.2 million for each year of the biennium."; and bill on page 127, lines 10 through 13, by rewriting the lines to read: "allocate the sum of two million four hundred twenty-seven thousand nine hundred seventy-five dollars (\$2,427,975) in each year of the 2015-2017 fiscal biennium to provide grants to Boys and Girls Clubs across the State to implement: (i) programs that improve the motivation, performance, and self-esteem of youth, and (ii) other initiatives that would be expected to reduce gang participation, school dropout, and teen pregnancy rates.
