Senator Brock

1 moves to amend the bill on page 27, lines 28-42, by rewriting the lines to read:

2 **"GOVERNMENTAL BUDGETARY TRANSPARENCY/EXPENDITURES ONLINE**

3 **SECTION 7.17.(a)** In coordination with the State Controller and the Office of
4 State Budget and Management (OSBM), the State Chief Information Officer (State CIO) shall
5 prioritize Information Technology Modernization funding and other available funds, as
6 follows:

- 7 (1) To establish a State budget transparency Internet Web site to provide
8 information on budget expenditures for each State agency for each fiscal
9 year beginning 2015-2016.
- 10 (2) To coordinate with counties, cities, and local education agencies to facilitate
11 the posting of their respective local entity budgetary and spending data on
12 their respective Internet Web sites and to provide the data to the Local
13 Government Commission (LGC).

14 **SECTION 7.17.(b)** The Internet Web sites mandated by this section shall be fully
15 functional by April 1, 2016. Each Internet Web site shall:

- 16 (1) Be user-friendly with easy-to-use search features and data provided in
17 formats that can be readily downloaded and analyzed by the public.
- 18 (2) Include budgeted amounts and actual expenditures for each State agency or
19 local entity budget code.
- 20 (3) Include information on receipts and expenditures from and to all sources,
21 including vendor payments, updated on a monthly basis.

22 **SECTION 7.17.(c)** Each State agency, county, city, and local education agency
23 shall work with the State CIO, the State Controller, and the OSBM to ensure that complete and
24 accurate budget and spending information is provided in a timely manner as directed by the
25 State CIO. Each State agency Internet Web site shall include a hyperlink to the State's budget
26 transparency Internet Web site. The LGC shall work with the State CIO to post data on the
27 LGC's Internet Web site in a consistent manner that allows comparisons between the local
28 entities providing data under subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of this section."
