1 moves to amend the bill on page 15, lines 16-25  
2 by rewriting those lines to read:

3 "SECTION 14. G.S. 14-415.15(a) reads as rewritten:

4 "(a) Except as permitted under subsection (b) of this section, within 45 days after receipt  
5 of the items listed in G.S. 14-415.13 from an applicant, and receipt of the required records  
6 concerning the mental health or capacity of the applicant, the sheriff shall either issue or deny  
7 the permit. The sheriff may conduct any investigation necessary to determine the qualification  
8 or competency of the person applying for the permit, including record checks. Investigation of  
9 the applicant's mental health history may only include the period of time beginning 120 months  
10 prior to the date of the application. No person, company, mental health provider, or  
11 governmental entity may charge additional fees to the applicant for background checks  
12 conducted under this subsection. In no case may the sheriff take longer than 90 calendar days  
13 from the date on which the application was submitted to issue or deny a permit under this  
14 section. A permit shall not be denied unless the applicant is determined to be ineligible  
15 pursuant to G.S. 14-415.12."
