1 moves to amend the bill on page 15, lines 16-25
2 by rewriting those lines to read:
3 "SECTION 14. G.S. 14-415.15(a) reads as rewritten:
4 "(a) Except as permitted under subsection (b) of this section, within 45 days after receipt
5 of the items listed in G.S. 14-415.13 from an applicant, and receipt of the required records
6 concerning the mental health or capacity of the applicant, the sheriff shall either issue or deny
7 the permit. The sheriff may conduct any investigation necessary to determine the qualification
8 or competency of the person applying for the permit, including record checks. The sheriff shall
9 make the request for any records concerning the mental health or capacity of the applicant
10 within 10 days of receipt of the items listed in G.S. 14-415.13. No person, company, mental
11 health provider, or governmental entity may charge additional fees to the applicant for
12 background checks conducted under this subsection. A permit shall not be denied unless the
13 applicant is determined to be ineligible pursuant to G.S. 14-415.12."
