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4 5 on page 1, line 15, by rewriting the line to read: "FOR HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE; AND TO REQUIRE A PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF MEDICAID ELIGIBILITY DETERMINATIONS BY COUNTY DEPARTMENTS OF SOCIAL SERVICES."; and

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on page 6, by inserting between lines 20 and 21 the following new section:

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14 15 "SECTION 11.5.(a) The State Auditor shall conduct a performance audit of county departments of social services' administration of the North Carolina Medicaid program. The audit shall examine the county departments of social services' accuracy in determining eligibility for Medicaid and their compliance with the requirements of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services and state law. The audit shall also consider the impact of the Department of Health and Human Services' policy decisions related to re-enrollment eligibility determinations. In conducting the audit, the auditor shall ensure:

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- (1) A representative sample of counties, including both urban and rural counties, is audited.
- (2) A statistically significant number of cases are audited in each county in the sample.

SECTION 11.5.(b) The audit required by Section 11.5.(a) shall include the State Auditor's examination of at least all of the following:

- (1) The accuracy of Medicaid application eligibility determinations.
- (2) The timeliness of Medicaid application determinations.
- (3) The accuracy of Medicaid re-enrollment eligibility determinations.
- (4) The timeliness of Medicaid re-enrollment eligibility determinations.
- (5) The accuracy of presumptive Medicaid application determinations.
 (6) The timeliness of presumptive Medicaid application determinations.
- (7) The controls and oversight county departments of social services have in place to ensure accurate and timely processing of Medicaid applications and re-enrollment.
