- 1 moves to amend the bill on page 3, lines 20-21, by inserting the following new subsection:
- 2 "(d) Inventory. – The North Carolina Historical Commission shall adopt rules that
- 3 incorporate principles and guidelines for making a determination that a monument, memorial,
- 4 plaque, statute, marker, or display qualifies as an object of remembrance. The North Carolina
- 5 Historical Commission is directed to identify and catalog objects of remembrance in the State
- 6 that are erected as of July 1, 2015 based on the principles and guidelines it adopts.
- 7 (e) Petition for Designation. – An entity exercising control of a monument, memorial,
- 8 plaque, statute, marker, or display that is not included in the inventory of objects of
- 9 remembrance prepared by the North Carolina Historical Commission may petition the
- 10 Commission to have a monument, memorial, plaque, statute, marker, or display designated as
- 11 an object of remembrance. The petition must be in writing and must state the reason, or
- 12 reasons, why the designation is sought. At any regularly scheduled meeting of the Commission,
- 13 the Commission may grant a petition for designation by a majority vote of those present and
- 14 voting."
