- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to conduct a
- 8 study of the use of electronic tracking devices to track individuals, vehicles, and other personal
- 9 property and determine what use of those devices should be a criminal offense. The study shall
- 10 include what uses of tracking devices should be allowed without the consent of the person
- 11 being tracked or the owner of the item being tracked.
- 12 **SECTION 2.** The Legislative Research Commission shall make an interim report,
- 13 including recommended legislation, to the 2016 General Assembly and shall make a final
- 14 report to the 2017 General Assembly.
- 15 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law."
