	2. Was primarily engaged in providing to inpatients, by or under
	supervision of physicians, (i) diagnostic services and
	therapeutic services for medical diagnosis, treatment, and
	care of injured, disabled, or sick persons or (ii) rehabilitation
	services for the rehabilitation of injured, disabled, or sick
	persons." SECTION 2. G.S. 131E-184 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
)	"(h) The Department shall exempt from certificate of need review the acquisition or
	reopening of a Legacy Medical Care Facility. The person seeking to operate a Legacy Medical
	Care Facility must give the Department written notice (i) of its intention to acquire or reopen a
	Legacy Medical Care Facility and (ii) that the hospital will be operational within 36 months of
-	the notice."
5	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.



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
