2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROVISIONS FOR LONGEVITY PAY FOR CLERKS OF
3 SUPERIOR COURT.
4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5 SECTION 1. G.S. 7A-101(c) reads as rewritten:
6 "(c) In lieu of merit and other increment raises paid to regular State employees, a clerk
7 of superior court shall receive as longevity pay an amount equal to four and eight-tenths
8 percent (4.8%) of the clerk's annual salary payable monthly after five years of service, nine and
9 six-tenths percent (9.6%) after 10 years of service, fourteen and four-tenths percent (14.4%)
10 after 15 years of service, nineteen and two-tenths percent (19.2%) after 20 years of service, and
11 twenty-four percent (24%) after 25 years of service. Service shall mean service in the elective
12 position of clerk of superior court, as an assistant clerk of court and as a supervisor of clerks of
13 superior court with the Administrative Office of the Courts and shall not include service as a
14 deputy or acting clerk. Service shall also mean service as a justice, judge, or magistrate of the
15 General Court of ~~Justice or Justice~~, as a district ~~attorney-attorney~~, or as probation or parole
16 officer."
17 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2015.
