## **HOUSE BILL DRH10489-MH-187** (04/27)

Prohibit Hunting From ROW/Buncombe County.

Sponsors: Representative B. Turner. Referred to: A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAYS OF PUBLIC ROADS IN BUNCOMBE COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** It is unlawful to hunt with a firearm or deadly weapon, or to attempt to hunt with a firearm or deadly weapon, any wild animal or wild bird on, from, or across the right-of-way of any public road or highway. **SECTION 2.** Violation of Section 1 of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor. **SECTION 3.** This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs, and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. **SECTION 4.** This act applies only to Buncombe County. SECTION 5. This act becomes effective October 1, 2016, and applies to acts
