1 moves to amend the bill on page 16, lines 23-28, by rewriting those lines to read:

3 **"DRIVER EDUCATION PROGRAM FUNDS/REPORT**

4 **SECTION 8.5.(a)** Section 8.39(h) of S.L. 2015-241 reads as rewritten:

5 **"SECTION 8.39.(h)** Subsections (a), (b), and (c) of this section are effective July 1, 2016,
6 and apply beginning with the 2016-2017 school year. ~~Subsections (a), (b), and (c) of this section~~
7 ~~are repealed effective December 31, 2017.~~ The remainder of this section is effective when this act
8 becomes law."

9 **SECTION 8.5.(b)** It is the intent of the General Assembly to determine the most cost
10 effective and most efficient method of delivering driver education to North Carolina students and
11 to identify best practices and programs for improving student outcomes on the written test and
12 road test as required by State law. To further this purpose, the Department of Public Instruction
13 and the Department of Transportation, Division of Motor Vehicles, shall review the current
14 process for timely transfer of data related to student outcomes on the written test and road test
15 required under G.S. 20-11 for a limited learner's permit and a limited provisional license, and shall
16 identify any obstacles, proposed resolutions for more timely transfer, and necessary changes to
17 State law to facilitate that process. The Department of Public Instruction shall also review data on
18 student outcomes under different methods of driver education program delivery, including the
19 student success in relation to whether a local school administrative unit contracted with a public or
20 private entity. The Department of Public Instruction and the Division of Motor Vehicles shall
21 jointly report on findings, including any proposed legislation, to the Joint Legislative Education
22 Oversight Committee no later than December 15, 2016."
