moves to amend Amendment 16, line 3, by deleting the word "A"; and 1 2 3 by deleting lines 4-9 and substituting the following: "A student who meets any of the following criteria shall not be counted in 4 measuring the school's withdrawal rate: 5 DW A student enrolled in a school with the intent expressed prior to 6 enrollment of only being enrolled for a finite period of time within the 7 school year shall not be counted in the measured withdrawal rate.year. 8 The school shall keep a written record of a student's stated intent for 9 finite enrollment. 10 A student who is withdrawn from the school pursuant to subdivision (3) 11 b. of subsection (b) of this section. 12 A student who is no longer qualified under the laws of this State for 13 C. admission to a public school in North Carolina, including due to the 14 student relocating to another state. 15 A student who (i) withdraws from the school for a family, personal, or d. 16 medical reason and (ii) notifies the school of the reason for withdrawal. 17 The school shall keep a written record of a student's stated reason for 18 withdrawal under this sub-subdivision. 19 A student who withdraws from the school within the first 30 days 20 e. following the date of the student's enrollment. 21 A count of school attendance shall be taken at least once during each semester 22 (4a) for funding purposes.". 23
