1 moves to amend Amendment 16, line 3, by deleting the word "A"; and

2  
3 by deleting lines 4-9 and substituting the following:

4 "A student who meets any of the following criteria shall not be counted in  
5 measuring the school's withdrawal rate:

6 a. A student enrolled in a school with the intent expressed prior to  
7 enrollment of only being enrolled for a finite period of time within the  
8 school year shall not be counted in the measured withdrawal rate year.  
9 The school shall keep a written record of a student's stated intent for  
10 finite enrollment.

11 b. A student who is withdrawn from the school pursuant to subdivision (3)  
12 of subsection (b) of this section.

13 c. A student who is no longer qualified under the laws of this State for  
14 admission to a public school in North Carolina, including due to the  
15 student relocating to another state.

16 d. A student who (i) withdraws from the school for a family, personal, or  
17 medical reason and (ii) notifies the school of the reason for withdrawal.  
18 The school shall keep a written record of a student's stated reason for  
19 withdrawal under this sub-subdivision.

20 e. A student who withdraws from the school within the first 30 days  
21 following the date of the student's enrollment.

22 (4a) A count of school attendance shall be taken at least once during each semester  
23 for funding purposes."


