1 moves to amend the bill on page 22, line 49, through page 23, line 7, by rewriting the lines to read:

3 **""§ 115C-150.15. Reporting to residential schools on deaf and blind children.**

4 (a) Request for Consent. – Local superintendents shall require that the following request
5 for written consent be presented to parents, guardians, or custodians of any hearing impaired or
6 visually impaired children no later than October 1 of each school year: "North Carolina provides
7 three public residential schools serving visually and hearing impaired students: the Governor
8 Morehead School for the Blind, the Eastern North Carolina School for the Deaf, and the North
9 Carolina School for the Deaf. Do you consent to the release of your contact information and
10 information regarding your child and his or her impairment to these schools so that you can
11 receive more information on services offered by those campuses?"

12 (b) Annual Report to Residential Schools. – Local superintendents shall report by
13 November 30 each year the names and addresses of parents, guardians, or custodians of any
14 hearing impaired or visually impaired children who have given written consent to the directors of
15 the Governor Morehead School for the Blind, the Eastern North Carolina School for the Deaf, and
16 the North Carolina School for the Deaf. The report shall include the type of disability of each
17 child, including whether the hearing and visual impairments range from partial to total disability,
18 and if the child has multiple disabilities with the visual or hearing impairment not identified as the
19 primary disability of the student. The report shall also be made to the Department of Public
20 Instruction.

21 (c) Confidentiality of Records. – The directors of the Governor Morehead School for the
22 Blind, the Eastern North Carolina School for the Deaf, and the North Carolina School for the Deaf
23 shall treat any information reported to the schools by a local superintendent under subsection (b)
24 of this section as confidential, except that a director or the director's designee may contact the
25 parents, guardians, or custodians of any hearing impaired or visually impaired children whose
26 information was included in the report. The information shall not be considered a public record
27 under G.S. 132-1.""; and

31 "the period of the student's attendance. A school that seeks to enroll foreign exchange students
32 under this section shall submit a plan prior to enrolling any of those students to the State Board of



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- 1 Education for approval, including the proposed costs to be charged to the students for attendance
2 and information on compliance with federal law requirements. For the purposes of this section, a
3 foreign exchange student";

7 "Local superintendents shall present the consent form to parents, guardians, or custodians of any
8 hearing impaired or visually impaired children required by subsection (a) of this section by
9 October 1, 2016, and shall make the first report required under subsection (a) of this section no
10 later than November 30, 2016."
