16 "SECTION 2.(g) Up to five receipt-supported positions are created in the Division of
17 Emergency Management of the Department of Public Safety to carry out the duties in
18 G.S. 130A-309.202. There is appropriated a sum of up to four hundred thousand dollars
19 (\$400,000) to the Coal Ash Management Commission from the Coal Combustion Residuals
20 Management Fund cash balance on June 30, 2016, to fund said positions or for the purpose of
21 executing contractual arrangements for engineering or other consulting services the Commission
22 determines are necessary or advisable to render requisite information and expertise on coal ash
23 management issues or otherwise support the Commission's work. The positions shall be used to
24 provide assistance to the Coal Ash Management Commission established by G.S. 130A-309.202,
25 as enacted by Section 2(a) of this act. The Division of Emergency Management in the Department
26 of Public Safety shall consult with the Chair of the Commission in hiring the staff for the Coal
27 Ash Management Commission. The Division of Emergency Management in the Department of
28 Public Safety shall provide support to the Commission until the staff of the Commission is hired,
29 including the designation of an individual to serve as an interim executive director of the staff.
30 Provided, however, that if the Environmental Management Commission assumes all powers and
31 duties for review and approval of proposed classifications for all coal combustion residuals surface
32 impoundments and closure plans for all coal combustion residuals surface impoundments pursuant



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1 to Section 2(d) of this act, then funds to be appropriated pursuant to this section shall instead be
2 appropriated to the Environmental Management Commission, which funds shall be used solely to
3 support the work of the Commission to review and approve proposed classifications and proposed
4 closure plans."
