1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ACQUISITION OR CONSTRUCTION AND THE 3 FINANCING, WITHOUT APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE GENERAL FUND, OF 4 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS CERTAIN PROJECTS OF THE CONSTITUENT 5 INSTITUTIONS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** The purpose of this act is to authorize (i) the acquisition or construction 7 8 of the capital improvements projects listed in this act for the respective institutions of The 9 University of North Carolina and (ii) the financing of these projects with funds available to the institutions from gifts, grants, receipts, self-liquidating indebtedness, Medicare reimbursements for 10 11 education costs, hospital receipts from patient care, or other funds, or any combination of these 12 funds, but not including funds received for tuition or appropriated from the General Fund of the 13 State unless previously authorized by General Statute. 5	SECTION 3. At the request of the Board of Governors of The University of	North
6	Carolina and upon determining that it is in the best interest of the State to do so, the Director	of the
7	Budget may authorize an increase or decrease in the cost of, or a change in the method of, fu	inding
8	the projects authorized by this act. In determining whether to authorize a change in co	ost or
9	funding, the Director of the Budget may consult with the Joint Legislative Commission	on on
10	Governmental Operations.	
11	SECTION 4. Pursuant to G.S. 116D-26, the Board of Governors may issue, subj	ject to
12	the approval of the Director of the Budget, at one time or from time to time, special oblig	gation
13	bonds of the Board of Governors for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost of acqu	uiring,
14	constructing, or providing for the projects authorized by Section 2 of this act. The max	imum
15	principal amount of bonds to be issued shall not exceed the specified project costs in Section	n 2 of
16	this act plus five percent (5%) of such amount to pay issuance expenses, fund reserve fund	· 1 •
17	capitalized interest, and pay other related additional costs, plus any increase in the specific p	roject
18	costs authorized by the Director of the Budget pursuant to Section 3 of this act.	

19 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
