Section 1.3.(a) of this act becomes effective October 1, 2017, and applies to policies issued, renewed, or amended on or after that date. Sections 1.3.(b) and 1.3.(c) become effective October 1, 2017, and apply to filings submitted on or after that date. Sections 3.1, 3.2, and 6.4 of this act become effective December 1, 2016. The remainder of this act is effective when it becomes law."
