1 moves to amend the bill on page 7, line 31 through page 8, line 3,
2 by rewriting those lines to read:

4 **"PART III. REIMBURSEMENT OF COSTS**

5 **SECTION 6.(a)** With funds available, the Department of Health and Human Services
6 shall (i) reimburse schools and child care facilities for the costs associated with testing drinking
7 water for the presence of lead as required pursuant to Section 2 of this act and (ii) pay for the costs
8 associated with the Department or a local health department conducting sampling and analysis of
9 drinking water on behalf of schools and child care facilities. The Department of Health and
10 Human Services shall reimburse each school and child care facility upon receipt of appropriate
11 documentation that authenticates the payment for and completion of the required sampling and
12 analysis for lead in drinking water.

13 **SECTION 6.(b)** The Divisions of Public Health and Child Development and Early
14 Education in the Department of Health and Human Services, the Department of Environmental
15 Quality, and the Department of Public Instruction shall use funds available to each agency,
16 respectively, to support the administration and implementation of Sections 2 and 3 of this act.

17 **SECTION 6.(c)** The Department of Health and Human Resources shall, with funds
18 available, coordinate with the North Carolina Government Data Analytics Center in order to
19 develop and implement the database and reporting infrastructure necessary to support the
20 requirements of Sections 2 and 3 of this act.

21 **SECTION 6.(d)** With funds available, and only after all costs associated with testing
22 drinking water for the presence of lead pursuant to Section 2 of this act are reimbursed in
23 accordance with subsection (a) of this Section, the Department of Health and Human Services may
24 reimburse schools and child care facilities for the costs incurred for (i) the provision of alternative
25 drinking water in accordance with Section 2(g)(2) of this act; (ii) identification and removal of
26 drinking water infrastructure that contains lead conducted in accordance with Section 2(g) of this
27 act; and (iii) installation of replacement infrastructure or water treatment devices upon receipt of
28 documentation that authenticates the installation of replacement infrastructure or such treatment
29 devices. Schools shall design and install any replacement infrastructure or treatment devices
30 required pursuant to this act in accordance with G.S. 133.1 and G.S. 115C-521(c)."
