1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPOINT PERSONS TO VARIOUS PUBLIC OFFICES UPON THE 3 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE PRESIDENT PRO TEMPORE OF THE SENATE, THE 4 SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES. AND THE MAJORITY LEADER 5 OF THE SENATE, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CHANGES. 6 Whereas, G.S. 120-121 authorizes the General Assembly to make certain appointments to public offices upon the recommendation of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the 7 8 Speaker of the House of Representatives; and 9 Whereas, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of 10 Representatives have made recommendations; and 11 Whereas, G.S. 143B-168.12 authorizes the General Assembly to appoint a member of 12 the public to the Board of Directors of the North Carolina Partnership for Children, Inc., upon the recommendation of the Majority Leader of the Senate; and 13 14 Whereas, the Majority Leader of the Senate has made a recommendation; Now, 15 therefore, 16 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 17 18 PART I.
