1 moves to amend the bill on page 9, lines 5-6, by rewriting those lines to read:

3 "SECTION 5. Sections 1 through 4.6 of this act become effective only if approved by
4 a majority of the qualified voters of the City of Asheville in a referendum. The election shall be
5 conducted by the Buncombe County Board of Elections on November 8, 2016. The question on
6 the ballot shall be:

7 "[] FOR [] AGAINST

8 Establishing election districts, as set out in Senate Bill 897, 2015 Regular Session, in
9 which the six members of the Asheville City Council would be required to reside and run."

10 SECTION 6. Sections 1 through 4.6 of this act become effective January 1, 2017, and
11 applies to elections conducted in the City of Asheville on or after that date upon ratification of the
12 approval by the voters of the referendum set forth in Section 5 of this act.

13 SECTION 7. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
14 law."
