The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SI	ECTION 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the current
configuration of the superior and district court districts in this State and make recommendations	
for adjusting those districts in order to improve the efficiency of the court system, provide for	
improved administration, and to better balance the caseloads in the various districts.	
SECTION 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report to	
the 2015 General Assembly when it reconvenes in 2016 and shall make its final report to the	
2017 General Assembly when it convenes	

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
