SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-84.2(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
"(1b) Notwithstanding subdivision (1) of this subsection, if a school is clo	sed due
	to inclement weather, a natural disaster, damage to a school facili	•
	state of emergency, the school is required to make up a maximum	n of the
	average number of days or hours made up for the last five years."	
SECTION 2. G.S. 115C-218.85(a)(1) reads as rewritten:		
"(1) The school shall provide instruction each year for at least 185 days of	
	hours over nine calendar months. If, however, a school is closed	
	inclement weather, a natural disaster, damage to a school facility, o	
	of emergency, the school is required to make up a maximum of the	<u>average</u>
-	number of days or hours made up for the last five years."	_
	ECTION 3. This act applies only to the Madison, Mitchell, and Yancey	County
school administrative units.		
SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with		
the 2015-2016 school year.
