1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO INCREASE THE SIZE OF THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF
3	COMMISSIONERS AND TO ALTER THE DISTRICTS TO COINCIDE WITH THE
4	DISTRICTS OF THE WAKE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1.(a) Notwithstanding Chapter 792 of the Session Laws of 1959,
7	Chapter 763 of the Session Laws of 1981, and Chapter 983 of the Session Laws of 1981, and
8	any modifications thereto by the Wake County Board of Commissioners pursuant to law, the
9	Wake County Board of Commissioners shall consist of nine members.
10	SECTION 1.(b) In the 2016 election, one member each shall be elected from
11	Districts 4, 5, and 6 of the districts used by the Wake County Board of Commissioners in the
12	2014 election, to serve a two-year term.
13	SECTION 1.(c) In the 2016 election, and quadrennially thereafter, two members
14	shall reside and run in the lettered districts established under Section 5 of S.L. 2013-110 and
15	used by the Wake County Board of Education for electoral districts, to serve four-year terms.
16	SECTION 1.(d) In the 2018 election, and quadrennially thereafter, the seven of the
17	nine members of the Wake County Board of Commissioners shall reside and run in the
18	numbered districts established by Section 5 of S.L. 2013-110 and used by the Wake County
19	Board of Education for electoral districts, to serve four-year terms.
20	SECTION 1.(e) This section is effective the first Monday in December of 2016
21	and shall be the basis for nominating and electing the members of the Board of Commissioners
22	in the primary and general election for that office in 2016 and after.
23	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding Part 4 of Article 4 of Chapter 153A of the General
24	Statutes and S.L. 2011-126, the structure of the Wake County Board of Commissioners shall
25	not be altered under that Part or Session Law prior to the return of the 2020 Census.
26	SECTION 3. This act applies to the County of Wake only.
27	SECTION 4. Except as otherwise provided, this act is effective when it becomes
28	law.
