4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. G.S. 130A-248 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
6	"(a7) Notwithstanding any provision of this Part, a permitted establishment that prepares or
7	serves food may use an outdoor grill to prepare food for customers if all of the following criteria
8	are met:
9	(1) The outdoor grill is made of stainless steel and is stationed on a level, concrete
10	foundation.
11	(2) The outdoor grill has a semi-permanent cover to protect it from weather, dust.
12	and animals.
13	(3) The outdoor grill, semi-permanent cover, and concrete foundation are cleaned
14	daily.
15	(4) Food prepared on the outdoor grill is processed inside the permitted
16	establishment, in the kitchen or in a room that meets the requirements of
17	sanitation specified for a restaurant kitchen."
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2017.
