HOUSE BILL DRH10074-ML-38 (01/11)

Short Title: DOT/Maintain Driveways Used by School Buses. (Public)

Sponsors: Representative C. Graham.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT DIRECTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAINTAIN AND
3 KEEP IN REPAIR CERTAIN PRIVATE DRIVEWAYS USED BY PUBLIC SCHOOL
4 BUSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF TURNING THE SCHOOL BUS AROUND.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 136-18(17) reads as rewritten:

7 "(17) The Department of Transportation is authorized and required to do all of the
8 following:

9 a. ~~The Department of Transportation is hereby authorized and required to~~
10 ~~maintain~~Maintain and keep in repair, sufficient to accommodate the
11 public school buses, roads leading from the state-maintained public
12 roads to all public schools and public school buildings to which children
13 are transported on public school buses to and from their homes.

14 b. ~~Said Department of Transportation is further authorized to~~
15 ~~construct~~Construct, pave, and maintain (i) school bus driveways and
16 sufficient parking facilities for the school buses at ~~those schools~~. ~~The~~
17 ~~Department of Transportation is further authorized to construct, pave,~~
18 ~~and maintain~~schools eligible under sub-subdivision a. of this
19 subdivision and (ii) all other driveways and entrances to the public
20 schools leading from public roads not required in the preceding portion
21 of this subdivision otherwise covered under this sub-subdivision.

22 c. Maintain and keep in repair any private driveway used by a public
23 school bus for the purpose of turning the school bus around. To be
24 eligible under this sub-subdivision, the owner of the private driveway
25 must submit written consent to the superintendent of the local school
26 administrative unit where the school to which the school bus is assigned
27 is located, authorizing the driveway to be used for the purpose of
28 turning the school bus around, and the superintendent must forward that
29 written consent to the Department of Transportation."

30 SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
