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HOUSE BILL DRH30180-MT-110B (03/14)

Short Title: School Cal. Flex./Certain Systems. (Local)

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FLEXIBILITY TO CERTAIN SCHOOL SYSTEMS
3 IN ADOPTING THE SCHOOL CALENDAR.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 115C-84.2(d) reads as rewritten:

6 "(d) Opening and Closing Dates. – Local boards of education shall determine the dates
7 of opening and closing the public schools under subdivision (a)(1) of this section. Except for
8 year-round schools, the opening date for students shall be no earlier than the Monday closest to
9 August ~~26, 14,~~ and the closing date for students shall be no later than the Friday closest to June
10 11. ~~On a showing of good cause, the State Board of Education may waive the requirement that~~
11 ~~the opening date for students be no earlier than the Monday closest to August 26 and may allow~~
12 ~~the local board of education to set an opening date no earlier than the Monday closest to August~~
13 ~~19, to the extent that school calendars are able to provide sufficient days to accommodate~~
14 ~~anticipated makeup days due to school closings. A local board may revise the scheduled~~
15 closing date if necessary in order to comply with the minimum requirements for instructional
16 days or instructional time. ~~For purposes of this subsection, the term "good cause" means that~~
17 ~~schools in any local school administrative unit in a county have been closed eight days per year~~
18 ~~during any four of the last 10 years because of severe weather conditions, energy shortages,~~
19 ~~power failures, or other emergency situations.~~

20 The required opening and closing dates under this subsection shall not apply to any school
21 that a local board designated as having a modified calendar for the 2003-2004 school year or to
22 any school that was part of a planned program in the 2003-2004 school year for a system of
23 modified calendar schools, so long as the school operates under a modified calendar."

24 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 115C-174.12(a)(4) reads as rewritten:

25 "(4) All annual assessments of student achievement adopted by the State Board
26 of Education pursuant to G.S. 115C-174.11(c)(1) and (3) and all final exams
27 for courses shall be administered within the final 10 instructional days of the
28 school year for year-long courses and within the final five instructional days
29 of the semester for semester courses. Exceptions shall be permitted to
30 accommodate a student's individualized education program and section 504
31 (29 U.S.C. § 794) plans and for the administration of final exams for courses
32 with national or international curricula required to be held at designated
33 times. A local board of education that has implemented a school calendar
34 that concludes the fall semester prior to December 31 shall be permitted to
35 administer assessments prior to the conclusion of that semester."



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- 1 **SECTION 3.** This act applies only to Onslow County Schools and Pender County
2 Schools.
3 **SECTION 4.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies beginning with
4 the 2017-2018 school year.
