HOUSE BILL DRH10149-ML-138B (03/14)

Short Title: Auto Dealers/Continuing Education. (Public)

Sponsors: Representative Brenden Jones.

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLE DEALER LICENSEES FROM  
3 CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. G.S. 20-288(a1)(2) reads as rewritten:

6 "(2) Proof that the applicant, within the last 12 months, has completed a 12-hour  
7 licensing course approved by the Division if the applicant is seeking an  
8 initial license and a six-hour course approved by the Division if the applicant  
9 is seeking a renewal license. ~~The requirements of this subdivision do not  
10 apply to a used motor vehicle dealer the primary business of which is the  
11 sale of salvage vehicles on behalf of insurers or to a manufactured home  
12 dealer licensed under G.S. 143-143.11 who complies with the continuing  
13 education requirements of G.S. 143-143.11B. The requirement of this  
14 subdivision does not apply to persons age 62 or older as of July 1, 2002, who  
15 are seeking a renewal license. This subdivision also does not apply to an  
16 applicant who holds a license as a new motor vehicle dealer as defined in  
17 G.S. 20-286(13) and operates from an established showroom 20 miles or less  
18 from the established showroom for which the applicant seeks a used motor  
19 vehicle dealer license. An applicant who also holds a license as a new motor  
20 vehicle dealer may designate a representative to complete the licensing  
21 course required by this subdivision. This subdivision does not apply to any  
22 of the following:~~

- 23 a. A used motor vehicle dealer whose primary business is the  
24 sale of salvage vehicles on behalf of insurers.  
25 b. A manufactured home dealer licensed under G.S. 143-143.11  
26 who complies with the continuing education requirements of  
27 G.S. 143-143.11B.  
28 c. A person age 62 or older as of July 1, 2002, who is seeking a  
29 renewal license.  
30 d. An applicant who holds a license as a new motor vehicle  
31 dealer, as defined in G.S. 20-286(13), and operates from an  
32 established showroom 20 miles or less from the established  
33 showroom for which the applicant seeks a used motor vehicle  
34 dealer license.
