| SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of | | |
| Health and Human Services, Division of Child Development and Early Education, the sum of | | |

twelve million dollars (\$12,000,000) for the 2017-2018 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-four

million four hundred thousand dollars (\$24,400,000) for the 2018-2019 fiscal year to eliminate

the waitlist for the Prekindergarten Program (NC Pre-K) statewide.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2017.
