Short Title: Amending Body-Worn Camera Procedures. (Local)

Sponsors: Representatives Quick, Harrison, and Brockman (Primary Sponsors).

Referred to:

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A COUNCIL OR GOVERNING BODY MAY VIEW  
3 BODY-WORN CAMERA RECORDINGS WITH THE CONSENT OF THE CITY  
4 MANAGER.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 132-1.4A reads as rewritten:

7 "§ 132-1.4A. Law enforcement agency recordings.

8 ...

9 (c) Disclosure; General. – Recordings in the custody of a law enforcement agency shall  
10 be disclosed only as provided by this section. A person requesting disclosure of a recording  
11 must make a written request to the head of the custodial law enforcement agency that states the  
12 date and approximate time of the activity captured in the recording or otherwise identifies the  
13 activity with reasonable particularity sufficient to identify the recording to which the request  
14 refers.

15 The head of the custodial law enforcement agency may only disclose a recording to the  
16 following:

- 17 (1) A person whose image or voice is in the recording.  
18 (2) A personal representative of an adult person whose image or voice is in the  
19 recording, if the adult person has consented to the disclosure.  
20 (3) A personal representative of a minor or of an adult person under lawful  
21 guardianship whose image or voice is in the recording.  
22 (4) A personal representative of a deceased person whose image or voice is in  
23 the recording.  
24 (5) A personal representative of an adult person who is incapacitated and unable  
25 to provide consent to disclosure.  
26 (6) A governing body with the consent of the city manager, upon a finding that  
27 disclosure is necessary to maintain public confidence in law enforcement  
28 agencies.

29 ...."

30 SECTION 2. This act shall only apply to the city of Greensboro.

31 SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
