A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT A COUNCIL OR GOVERNING BODY MAY VIEW 3 BODY-WORN CAMERA RECORDINGS WITH THE CONSENT OF THE CITY 4 MANAGER. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 132-1.4A reads as rewritten: 7 "§ 132-1.4A. Law enforcement agency recordings. 8 9 (c) Disclosure; General. – Recordings in the custody of a law enforcement agency shall be disclosed only as provided by this section. A person requesting disclosure of a recording 10 must make a written request to the head of the custodial law enforcement agency that states the 11 12 date and approximate time of the activity captured in the recording or otherwise identifies the 13 activity with reasonable particularity sufficient to identify the recording to which the request 14 15 The head of the custodial law enforcement agency may only disclose a recording to the 16 following: 17 (1) A person whose image or voice is in the recording. 18 A personal representative of an adult person whose image or voice is in the (2) recording, if the adult person has consented to the disclosure. 19 20 A personal representative of a minor or of an adult person under lawful (3) 21 guardianship whose image or voice is in the recording. A personal representative of a deceased person whose image or voice is in 22 (4) 23 the recording. A personal representative of an adult person who is incapacitated and unable 24 (5) 25 to provide consent to disclosure. A governing body with the consent of the city manager, upon a finding that 26 <u>(6)</u> 27 disclosure is necessary to maintain public confidence in law enforcement 28 agencies. 30
