#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE USE OF AN UNMANNED AIRCRAFT SYSTEM NEAR A 3 LOCAL CONFINEMENT FACILITY OR STATE OR FEDERAL CORRECTIONAL 4 FACILITY. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 SECTION 1. Article 16B of Chapter 15A of the General Statutes is amended by 7 adding a new section to read: 8 "§ 15A-300.3. Use of an unmanned aircraft system near a confinement or correctional 9 facility prohibited. 10 Prohibition. - No person, entity, or State agency shall use an unmanned aircraft (a) system within a horizontal distance of 500 feet or a vertical distance of 250 feet from any local 11 confinement facility, as defined in G.S. 153A-217, or State or federal correctional facility. For 12 the purpose of this section, horizontal distance shall extend outward from the furthest exterior 13 building walls, perimeter fences, and permanent fixed perimeter, or from another boundary 14 clearly marked with posted notices. Posted notices shall be conspicuously posted not more than 15 100 yards apart along a marked boundary and comply with Department of Transportation 16 guidelines. 17 Exceptions. - Unless the use of the unmanned aircraft system is otherwise 18 (b) prohibited under State or federal law, the distance restrictions of subsection (a) of this section 19 20 do not apply to any of the following: 21 A person operating an unmanned aircraft system with written consent from (1) the official in responsible charge of the facility. 22 23 A law enforcement officer using an unmanned aircraft system in accordance (2)24 with G.S. 15A-300.1(c). A public utility, as defined in G.S. 62-3(23), a provider, as defined in 25 (3)G.S. 146-29.2(a)(6), or a commercial entity, provided that the public utility, 26 27 provider, or commercial entity complies with all of the following: The unmanned aircraft system remains outside a horizontal distance 28 <u>a.</u> of 150 feet or a vertical distance of 150 feet from any local 29 30 confinement facility or State or federal correctional facility. 31 Notifies the official in responsible charge of the facility at least 24 <u>b.</u> hours prior to operating the unmanned aircraft system. 32 Uses the unmanned aircraft system for the purpose of inspecting 33 <u>c.</u> 34 public utility or provider transmission lines, equipment, or

44 45	<b>SECTION 2.</b> For the purpose of restricting the operation of an unmanned aircraft system in accordance with Section 1 of this act, the Division of Aviation of the Department of

Division shall publish designations by the FAA in accordance with this act on the Division 1 2 Web site. 3 At the request of the Division, the Social Services Commission of the Department of 4 Health and Human Services shall provide to the Division a list of local confinement facilities, 5 as defined in G.S. 153A-217, including facility location and a contact person for each facility. At the request of the Division, the Department of Public Safety shall provide to the Division a 6 7 list of State correctional facilities, including facility location, a contact person for each facility, 8 and each facility's operational status. 9 **SECTION 3.** The Division of Aviation of the Department of Transportation shall 10 develop guidelines for the content and dimensions for posted notices to mark boundaries in 11 accordance with Section 1 of this act. SECTION 4. This act becomes effective December 1, 2017, and applies to 12

13 offenses committed on or after that date.
