The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 1-17 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (a), (b), and (c) of this section, a plaintiff may file a civil action against a defendant for sexual abuse suffered while the plaintiff was under 18 years of age until the plaintiff attains 40 years of age." **SECTION 2.** G.S. 1-52 reads as rewritten: **"§ 1-52. Three years.** Within three years an action -For criminal conversation, or for any other injury to the person or rights of (5) another, not arising on contract and not hereafter enumerated, enumerated, except as provided by G.S. 1-17(d). Unless otherwise provided by law, for personal injury or physical damage to (16)claimant's property, the cause of action, except in causes of actions referred to in G.S. 1-15(c), shall not accrue until bodily harm to the claimant or physical damage to his property becomes apparent or ought reasonably to have become apparent to the claimant, whichever event first occurs. Except as provided in G.S. 130A-26.3, G.S. 130A-26.3 or G.S. 1-17(d), no cause of action shall accrue more than 10 years from the last act or omission of the defendant giving rise to the cause of action. (19)For assault, battery, or false imprisonment.imprisonment, except as provided by G.S. 1-17(d). **SECTION 3.** G.S. 1-56 reads as rewritten: "§ 1-56. All other actions, 10 years. An-Except as provided by subsection (b) of this section, an action for relief not otherwise limited by this subchapter may not be commenced more than 10 years after the cause
